The 2023 exhibition will be displayed online during March 2023 on the Carmel Arts Council website and at the Midtown Plaza big screen. The exhibition may be shown again on the Midtown Plaza big screen in July 2023 and October 2023. In person exhibit will be in the Carmel Arts Council Children's Art Gallery in March.

Because the exhibition is virtual, there is no limit on the type, or size of eligible artworks. If it can be photographed it can be in the exhibition! Each artist may submit up to four pieces.

To be eligible for the exhibition, art must be new i.e. not shown in previous exhibitions

family friendly and without overt advertising of a business, political party or religion

by an artist with disability residing in Carmel or participating in a program in Carmel.

## How to submit art:

Please email an "actual size" photograph of your work to CACD member Wendy Kiefel at <a href="wkiefel@gmail.com">wkiefel@gmail.com</a>. Smart phone pictures are fine. We want your art to look its very best. These easy tips will help you submit a great photo of your art

"actual size" means the largest file you can send. The picture to the right shows a photo being emailed on a smart phone. The 1.6 MB option is the best choice.

Fill the screen as much as possible with your art without cropping the image or losing focus. We want to see all the details!

Avoid glare and shadows by taking the photo in a space with good lighting
